It is our honor and privilege to award The Philip and Joan O’Hara St. John the Apostle Catholic School Scholarship which will be made available for the 2017-2018 school year.

The eligibility requirements are:

- Student must be a child baptized in the Roman Catholic Faith and who is actively practicing their Catholic faith at St. John the Apostle Catholic Parish.
- Student must be a child of an enlisted active duty U.S. military parent.
- Student must be entering grades K-8. This scholarship does not apply to Pre-K.
- The recipient family must demonstrate financial need by applying for assistance through the FACTS Grant & Aid module.

The recipient of the Philip and Joan O’Hara St. John the Apostle Catholic School Scholarship will be awarded \$5,000.00 applied directly to the reduction of their tuition for the 2017-2018 school year. An award letter will be submitted no later than May 31st to the parents of the recipient student.
