

COVID-19 Updates (effective March 23, 2020)

All St. John's activities, including Mass, are suspended until further notice.

On March 16, 2020, Bishop Barry Knestout of Richmond issued a letter announcing

- **the suspension of all public Masses** (Sunday, holy day, daily) at all parishes in the Diocese of Richmond until further notice
- **the suspension of all parish ministries, activities, and events** - including Religious Education, youth ministry, First Communion preparation, Adult Faith Formation, RCIA, etc. Also, Confirmation Mass scheduled for March 27 and First Communion Masses scheduled for the weekend of May 2 and 3 have been postponed.
